# Keys Meadow Guide to Returning to School During Coronavirus Pandemic





## Travelling to and arriving at School

- One parent can bring you to the school gate and wait with you in a distanced queue until you are collected by a member of staff who will take you and a few friends inside.
- Your parents cannot come into school at the moment.
- There will be a staggered start so your friends will arrive at different times. You will have a register and early morning work until all your friends have arrived at school.



## Home time

Home time will be different to normal home times at school.

- Your parent will not come to the classroom door but will wait at the gate for you.
- An adult will take you to the gate to meet your parents a few at a time.
- You will not need to take work or letters home so you will not need your book bag.



# Daily Routines



At first school will feel very different but you will soon get used to new routines.

- Every day will start with an adult collecting you at the gate. You will line up and then go to your room and have early morning work.
- You will wash your hands when you arrive in your room.
- You will have PSHE lessons to help you and your friends feel good. It's OK if you don't feel happy all the time. We will help each other.
- You will have lunch at your desk in the classroom and sometimes in the hall.
- You will have playtimes with children in your class.
- At the end of the day, your teacher will take you and your class to meet their parent at the gate.



# Keeping Safe

- You will only be able to bring your water bottle and packed lunch (if you have one) with you to school. You will not need any other equipment - don't worry.
- You will have to stay 2 metres (at least 3 steps) away from adults in school at all times.
- We will be washing our hands A LOT for 20 seconds at a time.
- You will need to use tissues to catch any coughs or sneezes and put these in the bin. Catch it, bin it, kill it.
- If you need first aid, an adult may have to wear a face mask and gloves when they help you.
- If you become poorly, your parent will collect you and take you home. You may have to stay there for a while and have a special test to check if you can come back to school.
- The staff will do their best to remind you how to stay safe and if we work together— we can do it!

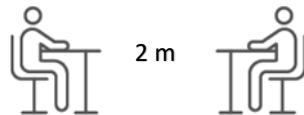
