


Nursery Curriculum Overview

Our World

As Discoverers/Historians we will be taking part in learning activities linked to our cultural backgrounds. We will be learning about our own family and that of others. Please email a photo of your family to school, so the children can discuss their families.

As Scientists we will be observing what happens as Autumn arrives and exploring the natural world around us during outdoor learning opportunities. What does the weather feel like? Do you notice any changes?

As Linguists we will be learning to communicate our needs using words and simple sentences. We will also show an interest in play with song and rhyme. Some rhymes will be sent home for you to practice together too.

Well-Being

As Religiously aware students we will be exploring the differences of others by celebrating others' culture. We will also be thinking about Diwali and how others celebrate the festival of light through creative and play activities.

As Athletes we will be exploring how we can use and develop our gross motor movements using outdoor equipment such as balls, blocks to balance on and hoops to jump in.

As Dancers we will be moving to a range of different music and exploring various ways we can move our bodies.

As Socially Aware students we will become familiar with the nursery routines and learn how to operate in a social setting by following instructions and sharing our toys with our friends.

Futures

As Artists we will be freely exploring different art materials and learning how to manipulate them to learn how they can be used. How do we use glue? What things can we stick together?

As Musicians we will learn to recognize the sounds of different instruments and move our bodies to a rhythm.

As Technicians we will be exploring how to engage with a variety of simple electronic equipment including I-Pads, interactive whiteboards and other small electronic equipment.

As Performers we will be developing our confidence when moving to music.

Standards

As Readers we will be listening to a range of short stories and joining in with nursery rhymes. Check regularly on Google Sites to find out which ones we are learning. We will also be learning to recognise different sounds in the environment.

As Writers we will be exploring different ways we can make marks in sensory media including writing with chalks and in paint, and by using water and large brushes outside. We will use the print in our Nursery to find and replace resources.

As Mathematicians we will be looking for numbers in the environment and learning to represent numbers with our fingers. We will also be exploring shape and space through different construction activities.
