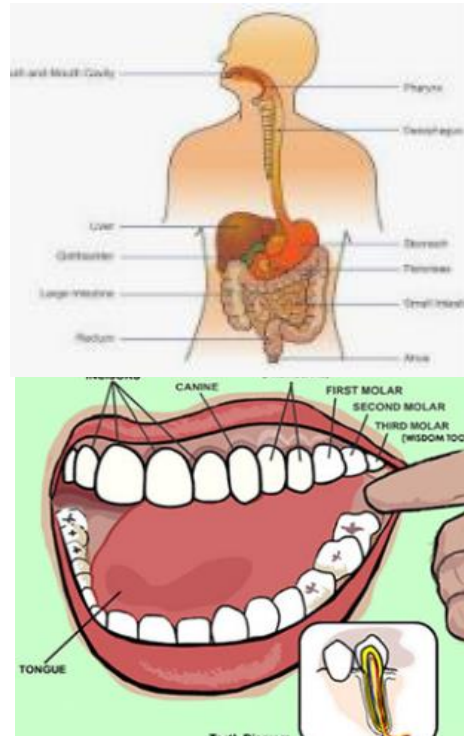
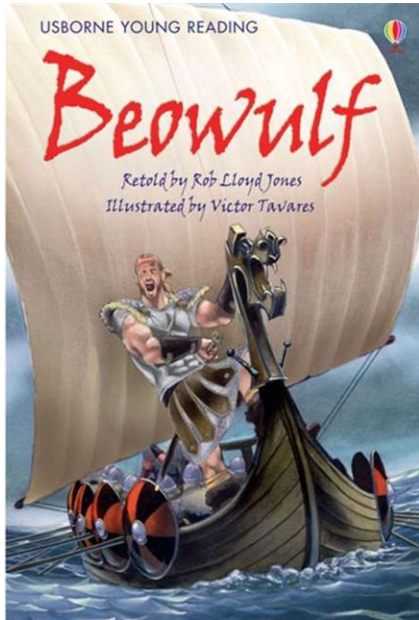


Year 4 Curriculum Overview

Our World

As Scientists we will be studying human and animal teeth, to understand their different functions. We will also learn about and describe the simple functions of the digestive system in humans.

As Historians we will build an overview of world history by investigating and interpreting the Anglo Saxon settlement of Britain. We will identify their main kingdoms and recognise the routes that Anglo Saxons used on modern day maps.

As Geographers we will be learning about the earth and why it is constantly changing. We will also be investigating and locating rivers, volcanoes, mountains, earthquakes and the water cycle.

As Linguists we will be learning how to count from 0-30 in Spanish. We also be learning the months and how to say the date in Spanish.

Well-Being

As Socially aware students we will be learning about relationships and identifying special people in our lives. We will identify and respect differences and similarities between families and learn about maintaining a variety of healthy relationships.

As Religiously aware students we will be learning about the teachings and beliefs of Islam, referring to their holy book the 'Qur'an' and learning about the importance of the Prophet Muhammad in Islam.

As Athletes we will be understanding how to position our body, feet and hands to pass a ball. We will be understanding how to use space and why it is important in invasion games,.

Futures

As Designers we will be developing our sewing skills and designing our own applique designs based on the Anglo Saxons' armour. We will be using these to sew our own applique cushions.

As Artists we will be using shading, hatching and cross hatching to show tone and texture to create our own drawings linked to the events and characters from our text, 'Beowulf'.

As Musicians we will continue to develop instrumental techniques whilst learning new chords and strumming patterns on the ukulele. We will recognise major and minor tonality and develop compositional skills when playing repeated patterns.

As Technicians we will be learning about computer networks including the internet, how they provide us with the world wide web; and the opportunities they offer for communication and collaboration.

Standards

As Readers we will be looking at the text 'Beowulf'. We will infer the feelings of characters and the reasons for their motives. We will also be retrieving information from historical texts to deepen our knowledge and develop our comprehension skills.

As Writers we will be exploring the story of Beowulf to write setting and character descriptions with an emphasis on appearance and character traits. We will also write a recount of the battle of Hastings.

As Mathematicians we will be consolidating addition and subtraction and deepening our understanding of these concepts through problem solving. We will also be calculating the length and perimeter of shapes as well as mastering multiplying and dividing numbers by 10 and 100.
