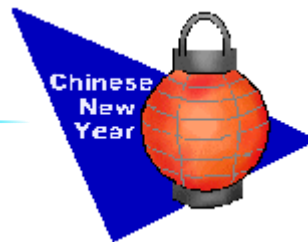


Nursery Curriculum Overview

Our World

As Discoverers/Historians we will be learning about Chinese New Year and looking at the different ways people celebrate this festival and why.

As Scientists we will be observing the changes in our environment during Winter and looking at what happens to the weather. We will be thinking about how it feels when we go outside and what we need to wear to look after ourselves.

As confident talkers we will be talking to our adults and other family members at home about our learning. Can you tell your adult what your favourite learning game today was? Maybe you can record yourself telling me about where you went today? Remember Bumblebees, keep talking and listening!

Well-Being

As Religiously aware students we will be looking at the traditions behind Chinese New Year. We will also think about what makes us different to other people.

As Athletes we will be thinking creatively about how we can stay fit and healthy at home. A daily physical challenge will be posted daily on Google sites! Make sure you keep active.

As Dancers we will be moving to a range of different music and seeing if we can move rhythmically to a beat.

As Socially Aware students we will be celebrating our own and others achievement with the 'I Can' programme to work towards our celebration badge. Make sure you are sharing your work daily so you can still work towards your badge.

Futures

As Artists we will be expressing our thoughts and opinions on our favourite stories through different artistic media and using what we have at home creatively. Remember you can be creative with anything!

As Musicians we will be continue to sing everyday during our live story session. Make sure you join in!

As Technicians we will investigate what technology we have in the home and thinking about we can use them safely and creatively.

As Performers we will be confident to talk as part of a group and display work completed, when online during our live class group sessions. Please join in everyday.

Standards

As Readers we are going to be reading Goldilocks and the Three Bears and learning some familiar phrases. We will also be describing main characters and events from familiar stories and giving meaning to print in the environment.

As Writers we will give meaning to our marks as we draw and paint. We will form letter shapes on paper and in sensory media. Check out the creative mark making document, linked on the Nursery timetable.

As Mathematicians we will match numeral to quantity and understand that a number can represent an amount up to 10. We will also be thinking about using positional language including under, behind, next to, in-front. We will be learning about flat shapes focusing on circle, triangle and square, and how we can use them in our artwork and construction.
