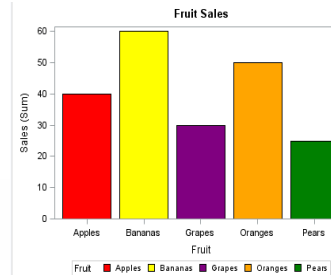
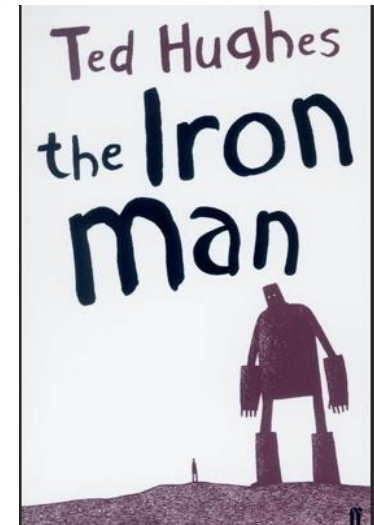
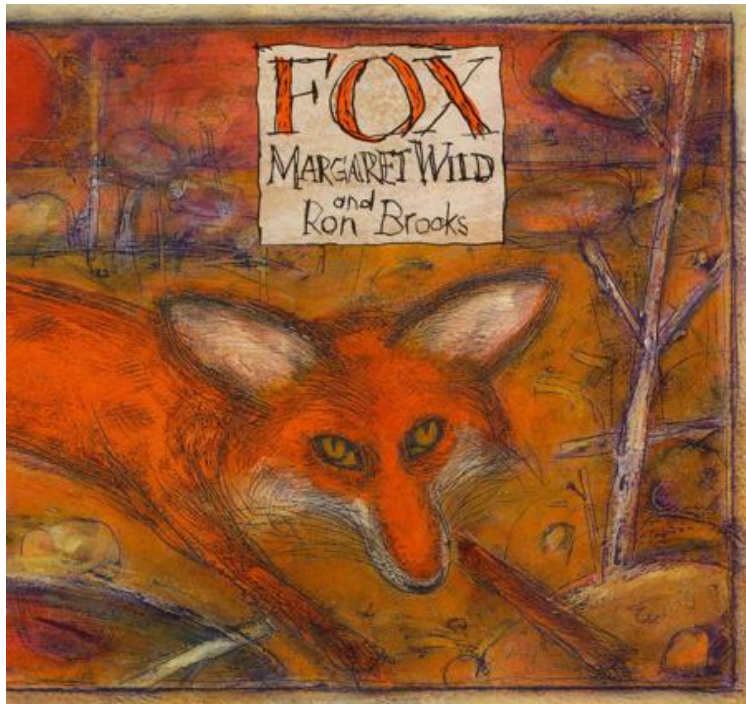


Year 3 Curriculum Overview - Spring 2

Our World

As Scientists we will identify different types of habitats and recognise that environments are constantly changing and that this can sometimes pose dangers to specific habitats. We will be focusing on pond life and habitats in trees and undergrowth.

As Linguists we will be beginning to understand and respond to a few familiar questions and short phrases in Spanish. We will be looking at the different body parts and the colours in Spanish.

Well-Being

As Dancers we will be performing and creating complex sequences to express our ideas in imaginative and original ways. We will also think about how to use movement to communicate ideas, moods and feelings when retelling the story of the 'Fox' through a dance.

As Athletes we will be learning how to play tennis. We will be working on our ball skills and will be thinking about how we can choose appropriate tactics to cause problems for the opposition.

As Socially aware children we will be thinking about different friendships and how we treat other. We will also be learning how to keep our environment clean and tidy in order to protect habitats.

As Religiously aware children we will be discussing different beliefs and cultures through our PSHE lessons, showing that we are all unique in our own way but we are still all apart of the same community.

Futures

As Artists we will be creating sculptures based on characters from the text 'Fox' using clay and other materials. We will also be creating our own habitats using a variety of different materials.

As Musicians we will be learning to play pitched songs on the xylophone, we will be listening to music daily and we will be learning about different genres.

As Technicians To understand what an algorithm is and to understand how use the Repeat command as well as debugging a programme.

Standards

As Readers we will be looking closely at the book 'The Iron Man,' by Ted Hughes. We will discuss the author's choice of language when describing and visualise and describe characters based on the text. We will also be summarising texts, looking at vocabulary and language and structure.

As Writers we will take inspiration from our text - 'Fox' and use this to construct a persuasive argument linked to the main characters predicament in the story. We will also use the story structure to write our own narrative and link this to our sharing.

As Mathematicians we will be focusing on measurement in mm, cm and m. We will convert between single and mixed units of measure. We will use our knowledge of number to compare, order, add and subtract measurements of length and calculate the perimeter of 2D shapes. We will also be identifying fractions and how to represent them in different ways for example as a bar model and using a number line and use this to make a whole out of two fractional parts.
