Our World

As scientists we will be Identifying and naming a variety of common animals including fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals. We will also be naming a variety of common animals that are carnivores, herbivores and omnivores. To bring our learning to life we will have a visit from Ranger Stu and his animals. We can't wait to see who comes to visit!

•As geographers we will be investigating pattern and places. We will tell the difference between physical and human features between coast, city and seaside. We will learn that we live in a city and think about all the features we have in our local area before comparing it to somewhere by the coast.

Futures

As musicians we will take inspiration from Beethoven's 5th Symphony to compose repeating rhythmic patterns on a range of percussion instruments. We will combine these patterns to create a collaborative class performance using dynamics, tempo and timbre.

As artists we will be looking at the work of Van Gogh and explore creating different tones with coloured pencils. We will experiment mixing primary colours to make secondary colours.

As technicians we will continue to be explore activities using a computer programme (Purple Mash). We will create our own story book and explore the difference between traditional books and E-books.

Well-Being

As gymnasts we will explore basic gymnastic actions on the floor and using apparatus. We will copy or create, remember and repeat short movement phrases of linked actions, e.g. a balance and a jump or a jump and a roll. We will perform our sequences to our class.

As reflective learners we will be working hard to earn our wristbands for Year 1. We will also learn about uses of technology inside and outside of school.

As religiously aware students we will be identifying artefacts and will be recognising symbols associated with Judaism. We will be looking at how Jewish families celebrate special occasions and we will discuss some religious stories.

Standards

As **readers** we will be working on applying all the alternate sounds we are learning in our daily reading sessions. We will continue to work on reading with expression and will work on talking about what we have read.

As writers we will be writing poems, animal fact files and making story maps based on the books 'On Our Blue Planet, In the Savannah' and 'The Emperor's Eggs.' We will be consolidating all our writing skills from this year by writing simple sentences with spaces, capital letters at the beginning and full-stops at the end.

As mathematicians we will develop our understanding of numbers to 100. We will learn to tell the time to the hour and recognise coins when handling money. We will continue to identify mathematical vocabulary in each unit.
